about Ron Clouzet

Ron E. M. Clouzet is the director of the NAD Evangelism Institute (NAEI), a professor of Christian Ministry and Pastoral Theology at the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary at Andrews University, and a field secretary of the North American Division (NAD). From 2007 to 2010, he was the NAD ministerial secretary. In 2011, he was the speaker for Hope TV's Prophecies Decoded, the satellite series involving 700 churches in a year-long comprehensive evangelistic approach that resulted in 5,000 baptisms in North America.

For 12 years, he was a pastor in Northern California, followed by 21 years of teaching ministry. At Southern Adventist University (1993-2006), he was professor of Practical Theology and later dean of the School of Religion. In addition to administrative responsibilities, he has taught ministry, preaching, evangelism, prophetic guidance, the Gospels, and Christian spirituality. In 1999, he received the Excellence in Teaching Award.

Dr. Clouzet has spoken in many church and scholarly gatherings (in over 50 countries) on topics such as the Holy Spirit, spiritual theology, evangelism, ministerial training, and the Christian life. Dr. Clouzet is a former president of the Adventist Theological Society, and the founder of H.O.P.E. University, his evangelistic meetings organization. He has written a number of scholarly and popular articles, as well as several books. His book *Adventism's Greatest Need: The Outpouring of the Holy Spirit* is considered essential reading on the topic and has been translated into Spanish, Portuguese, French, and Romanian.

Born and raised in Argentina, Dr. Clouzet graduated from La Sierra University and Andrews University (M.Div.). He also holds a Doctor of Ministry degree (D.Min.) from Fuller Theological Seminary, having researched on the subject of theological education, and has done post-doctoral work for a Doctor of Theology degree (Th.D.) in Systematic Theology at the University of South Africa, studying the baptism of the Holy Spirit in the writings and experience of Ellen G. White.
