

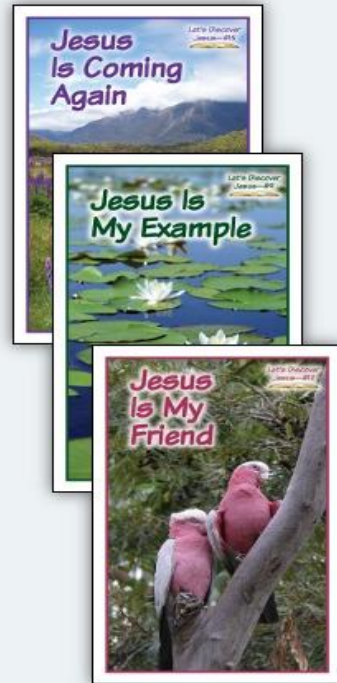

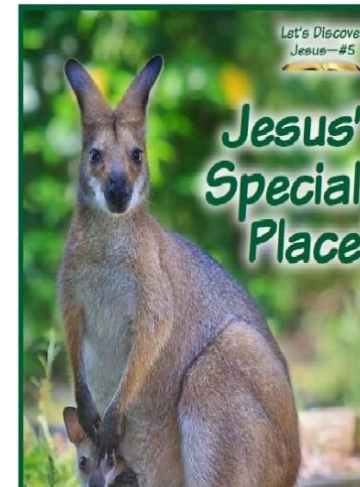

### A SANCTUARY

After God gave His Ten Commandments to the children of Israel, He wanted to talk to Moses. God said to Moses, "Come up to Me on the mountain" (Exodus 24:12). So Moses climbed up the steep mountain path. At the top, God was in a thick, dark cloud; and there He talked with Moses.

God told Moses He loved the Israelites so much that He wanted to live with them. They lived in little tents, and God wanted a special tent so He could live right beside them. How wonderful!

For 40 days God talked with Moses on the mountain. God told Moses just how to build His tent. God's special tent would be called a sanctuary. God wanted Moses to make it so the people would know about His sanctuary in heaven. It must be built very carefully. But where could Moses find materials for building the sanctuary?

On the night the Israelites left Egypt, the Egyptians gave them lots of gold, silver, brass, brightly colored cloth, and other valuable things. So God told Moses to collect an offering for the sanctuary from the children of Israel. God said, "From everyone who gives it willingly with his heart you shall take My offering" (Exodus 25:2). God only wanted gifts from people who gave cheerfully.

The Israelites were happy to give. They gave so much that finally Moses had to tell them to stop.

#### Lesson 20: The Sabbath

In our study of last day events we learned that in the earth made new, all will come and worship God from Sabbath to Sabbath. In this lesson we will learn about this Sabbath.

#### In review, let's study one verse again:

Isaiah 66:22, 23 – This verse mentions a Sabbath when the saved will come together to worship the Lord in the New Earth.

#### What Sabbath is this referring to? Let's go back to the beginning:

Genesis 1:31 and Genesis 2:1-3 – As a memorial of His work in creating the world, God rested on the seventh day. He blessed that day. He made that day holy. This was before there was sin. This was before there were different races of people. This was when EVERYTHING was perfect.

So we see that just as the Bible begins with a perfect world and ends with a perfect world, so this Holy Sabbath began in a perfect world and will also be in the perfect world at the end, as described in the Bible. It is this Sabbath that we need to study about.

#### When did the Sabbath originate?

Genesis 2:1, 2 – The Sabbath originated immediately after the sixth day of creation.

#### Who had the idea for the Sabbath?

Genesis 2:3 – God Himself

#### Whom was the Sabbath for? God?

Mark 2:27 – No, the Sabbath was not made for God, but for mankind!

#### Who is the "Lord" of the Sabbath?

Mark 2:28 – Jesus. It is Jesus the Creator I am to remember!

Where in the Bible are we reminded to "keep the Sabbath" versus throwing it out?

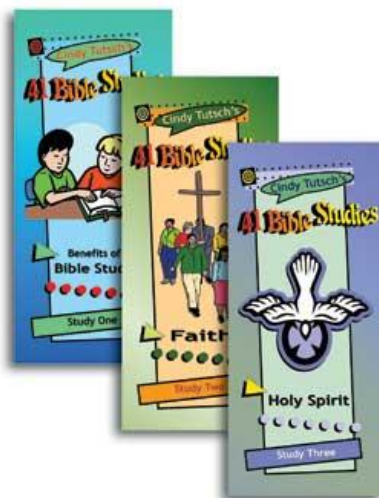

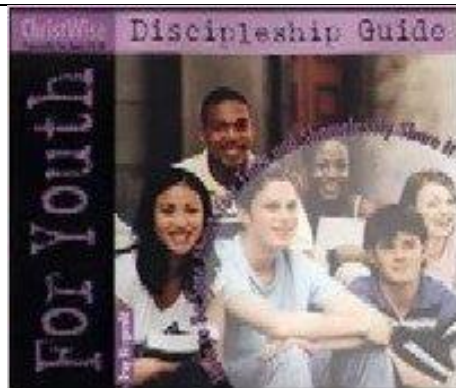

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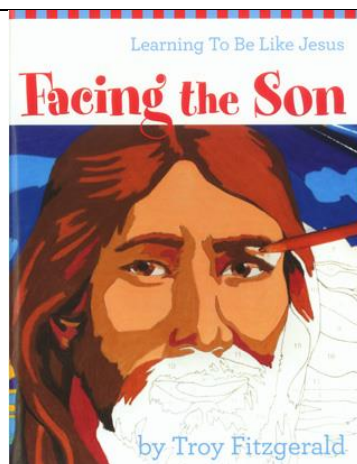
